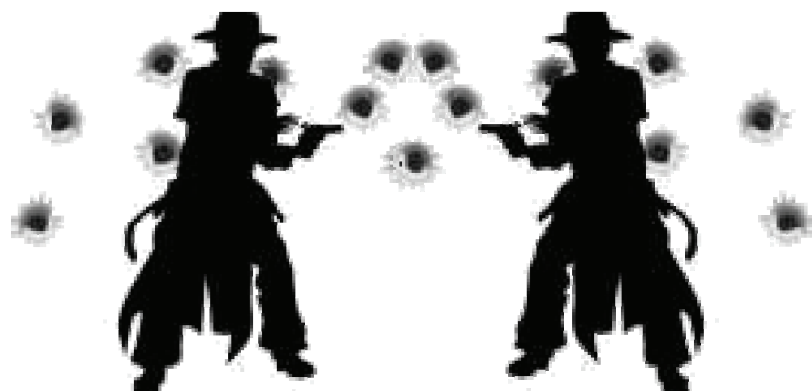

YOUTH BAKE SALE AUCTION

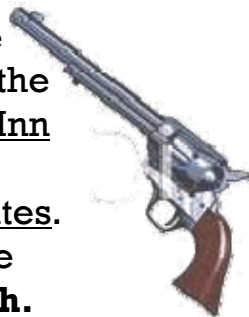

Directions to the Fairgrounds: From I-44, take Exit #83 and go west on Choctaw Avenue (Also US 277 & US 62); for approximately 1 mile. The fairgrounds is on the south side of the road BEFORE you cross over the railroad bridge. The exact address is Grady County Fairgrounds, 500 East Choctaw Ave., Chickasha, Ok 73018; (405) 224-2031.

IMPORTANT - Absolutely NOTHING may be **TAPED** onto ANY surface, including stalls, on the grounds except on the designated bulletin boards. Otherwise fines will be imposed. Please help keep the facility clean.



Stall Assignments - stalls will be available by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 19, and must be vacated by 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 22. These are 10 x 10 stalls, and have concrete floors. **No outside bedding may be brought onto the show grounds.** Shavings may be purchased at the Show Office or pre-purchased on the entry form. No more than two horses will be allowed in a stall. Stallions 2 years and older MUST be stalled separately. If you wish to stay over prior arrangements must be made in advance and additional fees may apply.

Lunch break - will be announced at a time determined by the Show Manager.

Concession stand - will be open on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Pizza will be available without cost to the exhibitors and show staff on Thursday evening near the Show Office.

Dogs - MUST be kept on a leash or penned at all times; and animals are NOT allowed in the show office building.

Smoking - is NOT permitted inside the office, barns or arena areas.



RV Hookups: There are a limited number of 20, 30 and 50 AMP RV Hookups available on the grounds on a first come, first serve basis. There is also water available and a dump station on site. Payment information is on the entry form. Parking for the RV's is on the east and west sides of the warm-up arena.

Parking: Please do NOT park on the east and west sides of the warm-up arena unless you are using an RV slot, or you may be asked to move your vehicle and/or trailer.

Host Hotels: When booking your rooms, please let the hotels know you are with the Red River Shoot-Out Miniature Horse Show to receive the special rates. Free breakfast is included with your stay.

Please Make Note:

This miniature horse show is approved by and conducted under the rules of the American Miniature Horse Association, Alvarado, TX. All horses MUST be registered with AMHA. A copy of both sides of the Certificate of Registration of each horse entered must be submitted to the Show Manager with each horse entry. Entries that are received without a copy of both sides of the registration papers will be held pending until such papers are submitted. A copy of lease (with AMHA stamp) for horses showing that are being leased. For geldings, gelding status must be reflected on the Certificate of Registration in order to show in any AMHA class. **Note:** Along with your registration papers, please send a copy of your Stallion Testicular Report for any senior stallion entered. No youth under 12 years of age may show stallions, except weanling or yearling colts.

Include a copy of the lease (with AMHA stamp) if you are showing a leased horse. No cross entry is allowed between single pleasure, country pleasure or classic pleasure driving - this includes open, amateur, and youth. AOTE & YOTE horses must be registered to the exhibitor on January 1 of the year being shown, to be eligible to show in the perspective AOTE & YOTE classes.

Also necessary are current Youth and Amateur AMHA cards, (and provide numbers on the entry form) and a **CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS**; also a current health certificate within 30 days of the show. Youth and Amateur cards may be applied for through AMHA or at the horse show office.



The Show Manager reserves the right to settle and determine all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or connected with or incident to this Show within the boundaries of AMHA's current show rules, and to cancel or combine classes. Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the grounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

NO LOGO'S, NAMES OR OTHER IDENTIFICATION OF PERSON OR FARM WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY EXHIBITOR, HORSE OR VEHICLE IN THE SHOW ARENA.

RETURNED CHECK FEE

Red River Shoot-Out will charge a \$40.00 return check fee on all checks returned.

REFUND POLICY

A full refund will be given if entries are cancelled in writing to the show manager before the closing date of the pre-entries. If entries are cancelled in writing accompanied by a veterinarian's or a doctor's certificate of inability to show. After the closing date of pre-entries, but before the official start of the show, all fees other than the stall and office fees will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds. Substitution of a horse will be accepted with no late fee.

Management is NOT responsible for any loss or damage to Liberty music. It is PREFERRED for there to be one CD or tape PER ENTRY. If there is any question as to if your CD will work on the show equipment, please have it checked with show management before turning it in for the Liberty class.

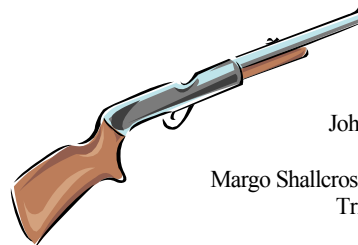

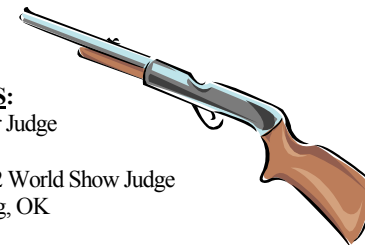

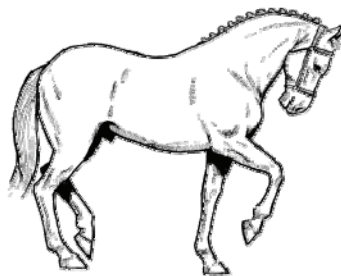

All horses are required to have a negative coggins within 12 months and a health certificate within 30 days. DO NOT send these in with your paperwork, but bring them to the show; as you will NOT be able to show without them.

SHOW 2 - High Point Awards

JUDGE'S EVALUATION FORMS - are no longer mandatory, but they may be filled out on a voluntary basis. Forms are available in the Show Office.



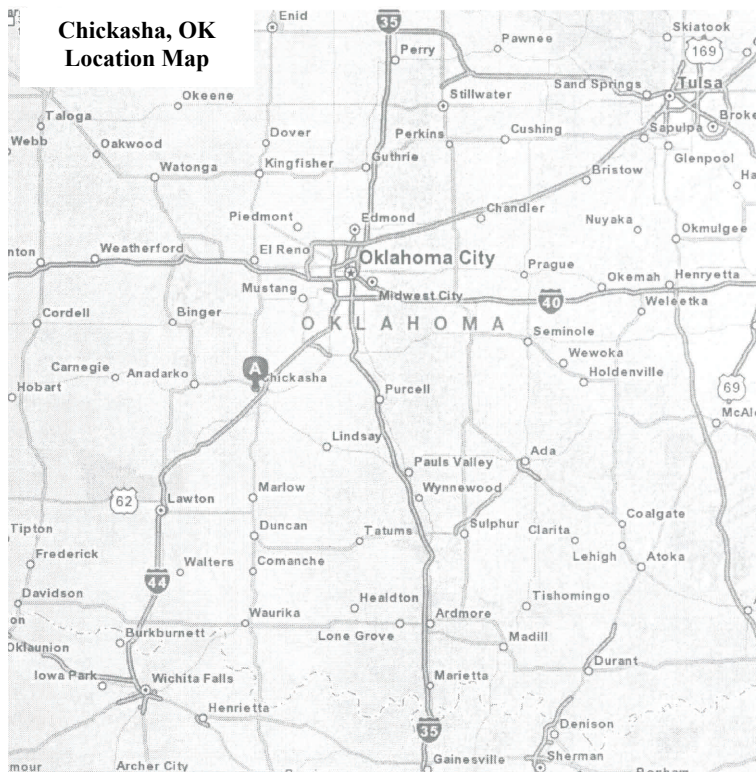

The map above is an area directional map to Chickasha. Chickasha (designated above with the “A”) is located off of I-44. It is approximately 30 miles south of Oklahoma City and 45 miles north of Lawton. The map to the right is a closer view of Chickasha, showing the location of the fairgrounds and hotel.

To get to the fairgrounds, off of I-44, take Exit #83 and go west on Choctaw Avenue (also US 277 & US 62); for approximately 1 mile. The fairgrounds is on the south side of the road BEFORE you cross over the railroad bridge.

The Best Western Chickasha our primary host hotel, is located off of I-44, Exit #80 on the Southeast corner of South 4th Street (also Hwys. 277 & 81) & Grand Avenue. It is approximately 4 miles from the fairgrounds. Hotel amenities include the game room, billiards, karaoke, Best Western Inn Restaurant (with a complimentary full breakfast buffet); cocktail lounge, dome-covered heated pool, spa and steam room, and exercise room, as well as other features; and for a non-refundable deposit, they allow pets.

The Holiday Inn Express & Suites is a little farther south on 4th Street and is on the west side of the road. It is a newer facility with an indoor pool and hot tub, work-out room, business center, free breakfast and guest laundry room; and for a non-refundable deposit, they allow pets.

Grady County has worked hard to update the facility at the fairgrounds and we believe you will enjoy the facility. All of the stalls are on concrete, and there is a driving warm arena available to use. For those of you who have RV’s; the main hook-ups are on the east and west sides of the warm-up arena, near the show arena. Please do NOT park in that area unless you are using an RV slot, or you may be asked to move your vehicle and/or trailer.

Please remember to keep the facility nice, **Absolutely NOTHING** may be **TAPED** onto ANY surface, including stalls, on the grounds except for the designated bulletin boards; otherwise fines will be imposed.

Visit the Southern Plains Indian Museum; or if you want to see some different horse power check out the Muscle Car Ranch or the Antique Automobile Museum. This location is also nine miles from Lake Chickasha, 11 miles from Lake Burttschi, and 19 miles from Indian City USA, 20 miles from Braum's Dairy Factory. There are many things to see and do while you’re in Chickasha.

There are many types of restaurants to chose from, including Italian, Mexican, Chinese, Steakhouses, BBQ and just good ol’ American home cooking.

Different types of shopping is available in Chickasha, but there is also a Wal-Mart, Walgreen's and grocery stores located near the hotel/restaurant area.
