This horse show is approved by and conducted under the rules of the American Miniature Horse Association, Alvarado, TX. All horses must be registered with AMHA. **A COPY OF BOTH SIDES OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS OF EACH HORSE ENTERED MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SHOW CHAIRMAN WITH EACH HORSE ENTRY.** Entries that are received without a copy of both sides of the registration papers will be held pending until such papers are submitted.

**NOTE >>>** Along with your registration papers, please send a copy of your Stallion Testicular Report for any senior stallion entered. This will save time when checking in.

All youth and amateur exhibitors **must provide a copy of their current AMHA Youth or Amateur card with their entries** and provide such #'s on the front side of the entry blank. Applications for both these numbers will be available at the Show Office. Please acquaint yourselves with current AMHA rules concerning youth and amateurs.

The Show Manager reserves the right to settle and determine all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or connected with or incident to this Show within the boundaries of AMHA's current show rules, and to cancel or combine classes.

This Show is qualified for both AMHA World Show points and Southwestern Miniature Horse Club High Point Awards.

**HEALTH REGULATIONS**

The State of Texas Animal Health regulations for ALL HORSES are as follows; each horse must be accompanied by a health certificate current within 45 days and a Negative Coggins (EIA) test within 12 months. **DON'T SEND THESE DOCUMENTS WITH YOUR ENTRIES.**

### **ENTRIES CLOSE: March 14, 2012**

REGULAR ENTRIES CLOSE March 14, 2012. A Post/Late entry fee will be charged for entries not postmarked by this date, of \$10 per horse. Post/Late entries will be accepted until 7:30 am March 24 & 25. Additional class entries will be accepted up to four classes before the class you wish to show.

### **MEASUREMENT OF HORSES**

Horses will be measured between the hours of 3:00 – 8:00 p.m., Friday, March 23rd. **ALL HORSES** must be measured. **\*\* If you can't measure within the set hours, please fill in the appropriate space on the entry blank as to when you would like to measure. If there is a problem with your time, we'll call you.**

### **STALLS: \$40.00 each**

Stalls are box stalls (10x10) wood construction, metal bars on clay floors. No more than 2 horses per stall. **NO BEDDING IS INCLUDED WITH STALLS & NO OUTSIDE BEDDING MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS.** Shavings will be available from the facility at reasonable rates. Horses may be brought for sale, but pay the appropriate stall fee and meet health requirements. Stall decorations are encouraged.

Stalls will be available at NOON, Friday, March 23rd. **All stalls must be vacated by 9:00 p.m. Sunday.** Those exhibitors wanting to arrive earlier or stay later must make advance arrangements with Show Management and additional fee of \$15/stall will apply. Sunday night stay-overs will pay \$20.00 per stall used, including tack stalls.

### **SPECIAL NOTICE ALL DRIVING EXHIBITORS**

There will be NO harnessing or hitching of Miniatures in the main aisle from the warm-up arena to the Show arena. Please harness in the side aisles and hitch up out in the warm-up arena. This is for safety and liability concerns. Thank you

### **JUDGE'S EVALUATION CARDS**

Judge's Evaluation Cards are no longer mandatory, but may be filled out on a voluntary basis. Cards are available at the Horse Show Office.

### **REFUND POLICY**

The SWMHC GLEN ROSE SPRING SHOW MINIATURE HORSE SHOW will give a full refund if entries are cancelled in writing by the closing date of the horse show. If entries are cancelled in writing and accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show, after the closing date, but before the official start of the show, 8:30 a.m. March 24th, all fees other than the stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds. **Substitution of a horse will be accepted with no late fee.**

### **COMMERCIAL EXHIBITORS**

The fee for commercial exhibitors is per day depending on the size of the booth and use of electricity. Tables & chairs are not provided.

Vendor spaces will be available as follows on a per day basis;

\$25 per day – 10' x 10' display or tent with no electricity

\$35 per day – 10' x 10' display or tent with electricity

\$50 per day – 10' x 20' trailer with electricity

**Pricing policy for amateurs** – The flat fee of \$90.00 will cover 6 classes for the same amateur/horse combination in amateur classes (**2 of those 6 classes may be open classes**). These classes **MUST** be entered on the entry blank. Classes entered at the show or classes in excess of 6 will be \$25.00 for amateur and \$30.00 for open.

## **RV HOOKUPS**

RV spaces are available thru the facility on a first come, first serve basis and may be reserved on your entry blank. Full Hookups, \$20/night.

## **AWARDS**

Rosette – 1st thru 6th place winners. Champion/ Reserve Champion/Supreme – neck sash

## **RETURNED CHECK FEE**

Unfortunately, due to a large number of returned checks at recent shows and increasing fees at banks, the Southwestern Miniature Horse Club will have to charge a \$40.00 return check fee on all checks returned.

## **HIGHPOINT AWARDS**

Each exhibitor or horse must declare their intention to be included in the High Point competition by marking the appropriate space on the back of the entry blank or signing up at the Horse Show Office prior to the first class they are to show in. Points will be calculated from the combined points of all three judges. Points will be awarded in inverse order of placing; 1st – 6 pts; 2nd – 5 pts; 3rd – 4 pts; 4th – 3 pts; 5th – 2 pts; 6th – 1 point, if there are 6 or more horses in a class. If there are less than 6 horses in a class, points will be based on that number of horses; ie; 3 horses in a class >>> 1st – 3 points; 2nd- 2 points; 3rd- 1 point. Championship classes and AOTE classes will not count towards point totals.

## **YOUTH HIGHPOINT**

Awarded to one youth/horse combination in each of three age groups (7 Years & Under, 8 thru 12 Years & 13 thru 18 Years). A youth may be in more than one combination, using a different horse. Points will be calculated from Youth classes only.

## **AMATEUR HIGHPOINT**

An award will be made to the one amateur/horse combination that accumulates the highest number of points in amateur classes. AOTE classes do not count towards this highpoint. An amateur may compete in more than one amateur/horse combination.
